## Add New URL Redirection

---

View Name	<input type="text"/>
Redirect To	<input type="text"/>
Show This Link	go.php/ <input type="text"/>

### View Name

The “View Name” is used internally to keep track of your redirected links. It will appear in the drop down at the top of the page.

### Redirect To

This is the full URL that the person will be redirected to. **Make sure to enter the http:// as well.**

### Show This Link

This is the keyword that will be used in your link, and it will show up as `www.yourdomain.com/go.php/keyword/`

### Example:

**View Name:** Test Redirect 1  
**Redirect To:** http://www.google.com  
**Show This Link:** google

Your link would then be: `http://www.yourdomain.com/go.php/google/`

## Keeping Track Using Trackers

ULC includes a feature called “trackers” to help you find out which links are being clicked on if they are posted on different websites.

This is done by adding a certain keyword, or “tracker” to the end of the link created by ULC. For example, if you have a link that is posted on Craigslist, and the same link is posted on your website you can create two trackers in the following way:

Craigslist Tracker URL: [http://www.yourdomain.com/go.php/keyword/\\_craig/](http://www.yourdomain.com/go.php/keyword/_craig/)  
Website: [http://www.yourdomain.com/go.php/keyword/\\_site/](http://www.yourdomain.com/go.php/keyword/_site/)

When a visitor clicks on your Craigslist link, it will show up in your statistics area as **\_craig** and when a visitor clicks on your website link it will show up as **\_site**.

Trackers can be added dynamically to the end of your redirection URL. For example, if you are emailing your customers, you can add the email address as a tracker in the following way:

[http://www.yourdomain.com/go.php/keyword/\\_customer@email.com](http://www.yourdomain.com/go.php/keyword/_customer@email.com)

This allows you to see which email addresses are most responsive in a certain mailing.

**As you can see this allows great flexibility in tracking exactly where your clicks are coming from without having to take the time to add a new link for each site.**
